#### **Employment Program**

• Over the past five years Options has provided employment-related services to 755 individuals with various disabilities.

\*These services include competitive integrated job placement, job training, follow-up services, job exploration, resume preparation, job skills training and soft skills training. Options provides every essential employment service for individuals to obtain and maintain their employment goals.

• Over the past five years Options assisted 419 individuals with disabilities in finding \*competitive integrated employment in the community.

\*Competitive integrated employment – an employee with a disability earns a similar wage and benefits as employees without disabilities that do the same work. Integrated means working with co-workers, customers, and suppliers with and without disabilities.

• Since July 1 of 2022, Options has seen a 97% increase in referrals, showing the high demand for individuals in the community needing assistance in employment related services.

\*Referrals – individuals with disabilities that have requested assistance in obtaining employment related assistance through Options Unlimited services.

• Options has assisted individuals in finding employment at various employers based on their individual skills and work interests.

\*Options currently has individuals employed at UPS Worldport, Dick's Sporting Goods, Five Guys, Papa John's, Valu-Market, Lowes, Chick-fil-a, Misa Metal Fabricating, Best Buy Distribution, Ford Motor Company, Wallitsch Nursery, Ace Hardware, Starbucks, Cinemark, McDonald's, Kroger, Walgreens, Alliance Entertainment, Pizza Hut, HJI Supply Chain Solutions, Zaxby's, VA Hospital, Tumbleweed, Bon Air Library, and Cinemark

#### **UPS TLC**

- Since the inception of the Options Unlimited UPS Transitional Learning Center (TLC) located at the UPS Worldport, 683 individuals with disabilities have participated in the training program.
- Currently 275 individuals are actively working at UPS Worldport that successfully completed the UPS TLC program.

#### Forever Yes! Program

• The Forever Yes! Program has over 300 participants annually from Bullitt County Public Schools and Jefferson County Public Schools.

\*Through guided discussion and interactive participation, Forever YES! Peer Mentor Team educates, assists, and guides students with disabilities in learning the skills needed to help take charge of their life, gain independence, advocate for themselves, and successfully participate in school, employment, recreation, and other community activities.

• The Forever Yes! Program is currently active in Bullitt East H.S., North Bullitt H.S., Bullitt Central H.S., Butler H.S., Pleasure Ridge Park H.S., Doss H.S., Fairdale H.S., Waggner H.S., Ballard H.S., Eastern H.S., Shawnee H.S., Central H.S., Manual H.S., Southern H.S., Jeffersontown H.S., Male H.S., Ahrens, PACT, Phoenix School of Discovery, and Binet.

#### **Adult Day Program**

 Adult Day Program assists 25 individuals with a wide range of disabilities on an annual basis with a focus on independent living skills and daily community outings.
